# CARE RECOMMENDATIONS for NEW FLOORS

Floors take the greatest abuse of any building surface, so regular maintenance is essential in protecting a flooring investment. The life of your new floor depends on a consistent cleaning program carried out by trained, conscientious employees or a contract cleaning service.

High performance floor coatings may need up to two weeks to achieve their maximum degree of cure. Use extra caution during this "break-in period," before chemical and abrasion resistance properties are at their optimum. Dirt is also an abrasive material. When carried in on peoples' shoes and equipment, it may act like sandpaper, scratching a floor's finish.

Keep your new floor looking and performing its best by following these Care Recommendations.

## CARE RECOMMENDATIONS

<b>Sweep or Dry Mop</b>	Every day with a broom or power sweeper.
<b>Scrub</b>	A minimum of once a week. Use clean equipment and clean water and change the water often. Add a cleaning product suitable for your environment to loosen soil, grease, oil, and other contaminants and make the job easier.
<b>Clean</b>	All spills immediately and avoid spreading them. This minimizes the chance that aggressive chemicals could dull, stain or soften the finish.
<b>Repair</b>	Scratches, chips and gouges whenever the underlying surface (usually concrete) is exposed.
<b>Prevent</b>	Employees from dragging or sliding heavy equipment or pallets across the floor through proper training. Avoid dropping sharp or heavy items and spinning fork-truck wheels. Steer clear of strong, caustic cleaning solutions or stiff bristle brushes when cleaning your floor.
<b>Remember</b>	The harsher the environment, the more frequent cleaning the floor needs. Dust and dirt dull the finish unless they're removed on a regular basis. They also inhibit performance of ESD control coatings.

<b>Restore</b>	Use when surface shine needs rejuvenation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Concare Solutions® Shine Solution™</li></ul>
<b>Safety</b>	Use to enhance surface traction: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Concare Solutions® Sure Step Solution™</li></ul>
<b>Equipment</b>	Mechanized with a <b>soft</b> nylon bristle brush.

**Note:** When cleaning ESD control floors, always following cleaning procedures with a clear water rinse to remove all cleaner residues, which may inhibit electrical performance.
